Fares for Food Day raises \$5,300 – good for 23,850 meals

An even \$5,300 was raised as part of Fares for Food Day – good for 23,850 meals to be served this giving season.

The money collected on DART buses Thursday, December 12, is being donated to the Food Bank of Iowa, which can provide 4.5 meals for every \$1 donation. Approximately 40 percent of the money raised came from cash that was donated on top of standard fare.

A presentation of the donation is at 2:30 p.m. today at Food Bank of Iowa, 2220 E. 17th St., Des Moines.

According to the Food Bank of Iowa:

- 1 in 8 lowans is food insecure;
- 1 in 5 lowa children does not have enough to eat;
- 395,620 lowans live at or below the poverty line.
