Job seekers invited to test drive a career in transit

Applicants can drive a 40-foot transit bus during DART's job fair

The Des Moines Area Regional Transit Authority (DART) is inviting anyone interested in a career in transit to get behind the wheel of a bus. DART is hosting a hiring event at the lowa State Fairgrounds where job applicants can drive a 40-foot-long transit bus through an obstacle course.

DART is looking to hire 35 bus operators for both our Fixed Route and Paratransit services. Applicants should bring their driver's license to the hiring event to drive a bus. Applicants should be 21-years-old or older. DART Human Resources staff will be on-site to collect applications and conduct job interviews. Applicants do not need to have their Commercial Driver's License (CDL) to be hired. DART is offering a \$3,000 sign-on incentive to new drivers with a CDL and a \$2,000 sign-on incentive to new drivers without a CDL to be paid out over their first year of employment. Interested applicants can also apply direct on DART's website at ridedart.com/careers.
