Buses remain on detour in downtown Des Moines due to Younkers fire

DART buses will remain on detour and several bus stops will remain temporarily closed in downtown Des Moines on Monday due to ongoing street closures surrounding the scene of the Younkers fire. The detours will be in effect and the bus stops closed until the streets reopen. DART Central Station remains open.

Riders are advised to expect delays in the downtown area due to anticipated traffic congestion.

Twenty-two routes will be on detour, including local Routes 1, 3, 4, 5, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, 51, 52 and 60; the D-Line and LINK shuttles; and Express Routes 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96, 98 and 99. Details are available online at www.ridedart.com or by calling DART Customer Service at 515-283-8100.
