No DART service on Independence Day

The Des Moines Area Regional Transit Authority (DART) will not operate bus service and administrative offices will be closed on Independence Day, Sunday, July 4, 2021. Bus service will operate on the day before and after the holiday.

## Holiday service schedule

DART will operate the following service for Independence Day

- Saturday, July 3, 2021 DART buses will operate regular Saturday service schedule.
- Sunday, July 4, 2021 DART will not operate service. All offices and DART Central Station closed.
- Monday, July 5, 2021 DART will operate regular weekday service. DART Administrative offices are closed.
